

Facing NYCHA Termination because of an Arrest?

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!

1. You don't have to sign anything at the first appointment! You can ask for an adjournment to find a lawyer or get legal advice.

2. You have the right to see your entire tenant file and to see any documents NYCHA wants to use against you.

3. You have the right to an interpreter and to get documents translated in another language.
